



## Redundancy Support

For anyone facing redundancy, Working Wales can provide free expert advice and the most up-to-date support available to help you move forward from redundancy with confidence.

### We can work with you to:

- Understand and manage your emotions.
- Assess your options.
- Identify your transferrable skills.
- Help you gain new skills by finding courses and training and if required, seeking financial assistance.
- Search for jobs and match your existing skills to current vacancies.
- Support you through the application and interview process to help you find and secure a new job.

### \*ReAct - Financial support

You could be entitled to funding for training through ReAct, to allow you to improve and increase your skills and increase your chances of getting a new job.

#### Through ReAct, eligible applicants could receive:

- **Up to £1,500** in a **Vocational Training Grant**.  
This can be used towards the cost of training to help you get a new job.
- **Up to £200** in an **Extra Support Grant**.  
This is to help with travel, accommodation, childcare costs and specialist equipment needed.

*When you're offered a job, your new employer could also receive some funding. Eligible employers could access the Employer Recruitment and Training element of ReAct to get up to £3000 for taking you on and up to £1000 towards training costs.*

\*ReAct is part-funded by the European Social Fund through the Welsh Government.
